Cavalcade of Authors is collaborating with Columbia Basin College (CBC), the The Dream Builders Foundation, Children's Reading Foundation and Mid-Columbia Lit Fest to present a literary/writing conference for middle school and high school students in Benton and Franklin counties. Approaching its seventh year, the Cavalcade of Authors has grown from 70 students and one middle school in Richland with a \$4,000 budget to 1000 students from 28 secondary schools in the Tri-Cities, Connell, Yakima and Umatilla school districts in 2014. We are looking to raise nearly \$40,000 this year to help pay for our 17 authors and to seed for the following year. To meet the demand of the increased numbers of schools and students that want to participate this year while working to minimize the amount of money schools must pay, we are requesting sponsorships of up to \$5,000.

Adolescent literacy is a significant need in our community and this program promotes reading and writing skills in an engaging and unique way. The response from students, teachers, as well as the authors has been positive and encouraging. It is our hope that the program will grow and expand to become a truly regional event that draws all students from throughout the Southeastern Washington region.
